\$1,000 Scholarship Application Form for College Students

The Panhandle Press Association and Texas Press Association awards the PPA Scholarship of \$1,000 payable over two semesters at \$500 per semester during which journalism courses are taken at the recipient's college of choice. College students must live in or be from a county served by a Panhandle Press Association member newspaper. Applicants must have completed at least 24 hours of college credit and must be majoring in a Mass Communications field of study with a demonstrated interested in Print Journalism or Advertising. Recipients must be enrolled in at least three hours of college or university journalism courses each semester that the scholarship is awarded. Students must fill out the following application and submit a 250 word essay on the subject, "My Future and Career Plans in Community Journalism."
