## \$1,000 Scholarship Application Form for Graduating High School Seniors

The Panhandle Press Association and Texas Press Association awards the PPA Scholarship of \$1,000, payable over two semesters at \$500 per semester, during which journalism courses are taken at the recipient's college of choice. Students who will graduate from high school in this spring and who live in a county served by a Panhandle Press Association member newspaper are eligible to apply for this scholarship. The student must plan to major in a Mass Communications field of study with a demonstrated interested in Print Journalism or Advertising. Students must fill out the following application and submit a 250 word essay on the subject, "My Future and Career Plans in Community Journalism."
